Registration Information

You may register at our office in the high school, by mail or by phone. We accept cash, checks, money orders or you may pay through eFunds (see instruction lower right hand corner of this page. Please make checks payable to "Linden Community Education". A drop box is located outside the main high school office for your convenience. Please register as soon as possible to secure your place in a class. Registration will be taken until the day a program begins. However, if a class has low enrollment, it may be cancelled a few days before the scheduled start date, please make sure to call to inquire as to whether the class is running. Unfortunately classes may have to be cancelled due to low enrollment. Early registration will help to ensure that a class will take place as scheduled.



Refund Policy

A full refund will be given if the class is cancelled by Linden Community Education or if the request is made prior to the first class. Refunds will be granted upon request up until the second class minus a \$5.00 administrative fee. Please allow 2-3 weeks to process refunds.

Confirmation Procedure

Linden Community Education will only notify participants if a class is full or has been cancelled. We will notify you immediately if a class is cancelled and a full refund will be issued. If you do not hear from our office, please attend the first class session as scheduled.

Cancellation Procedure

Linden Community Education reserves the right to cancel any program due to inclement weather, building problems, low enrollment of conditions beyond


